2024 + + First Destination ⁺ Survey Highlights

The data for this report were collected by online survey, follow-up telephone calls, faculty, and social media. The Office of Career Services surveyed undergraduate students who received first-time bachelor degrees between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024. The report is based on a knowledge rate of 80% (or 332 graduates of the 413 receiving traditional undergraduate degrees).

Of the 332 respondents:

- (96%) Career outcome rate
 (% of graduates who fall into employed FT/PT related,
 employed FT/PT unrelated,
 volunteer service, military, or continued education.)
- **199** (60%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT related)
- 42 (13%) reported "Employed" (FT/PT unrelated)
- **76** (23%) reported "Continuing Education"
- 233 (78%) reported working in North Dakota
